

PROVINCIAL DROP LEAF TABLE

What you need:

Sanding block
Rag
Valspar Furniture Paint
Valspar Antiquing Glaze
Stir stick
Paintbrush
Small roller (optional)
Paint tray (optional)

What you do:

1. Prep the table. Sand and wipe down smooth surfaces.
 2. Stir up the paint and apply a smooth, even coat.
 3. Let it dry for 24 hours.
 4. Add a second coat of color to cover any imperfections.
 5. Give it another 24 hours.
 6. Start the antiquing. Run a sanding block along the edges to expose some wood underneath.
 7. Brush on a thick layer of antiquing glaze, then gently wipe it off with a rag, leaving the desired effect. Go section by section so the glaze doesn't dry.
- EXPERT TIP: Leave more glaze along the bottom, where more wear and tear would naturally occur over time.
8. Let the glaze dry for 24 hours.
 9. Voila! Good as new. Or good as old? Either way, good.
